Suffixes You Practiced (yay!)

- -ful → full of
- -ive → tending toward an action
- -ine → like
- -ic & -ual (-al) → relating to/characterized by
- -able & -ible → can be done/able to
- -ed → past tense!

Original Word	Analysis: Stem + Suffix	Is the original word a noun, or is it an adjective, or is it both?
survival	<i>surviv</i> / + <i>al</i>	<i>Noun</i>
principal	<i>princip</i> + <i>al</i>	<i>Both</i>

Adjective	= Stem + Suffix	Is the stem a noun, or is it bound?
actual	= <i>act</i> + <i>ual</i>	<i>Noun</i>
presidential	= <i>president</i> + <i>ial</i>	<i>Noun</i>
